IN 2019, THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE PUBLISHED THE RECOMMENDATION: 'LIVES SAVED. RIGHTS PROTECTED'. THE RECOMMENDATION, WHICH IS A NON-LEGALLY BINDING ACT WITHIN THE EUROPEAN UNION, AIMED TO PROTECT REFUGEES, ASYLUM-SEEKERS AND MIGRANTS CROSSING THE MEDITERRANEAN SEA. MEMBER STATES OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE MUST, IN FACT, RESCUE PEOPLE AND PROTECT THEIR RIGHTS. THEREFORE, THE AIM OF THE RECOMMENDATION WAS TO GIVE SUGGESTIONS ON HOW STATES CAN OPERATE TO ENSURE THESE RIGHTS
